2-Year Limited -Term – Lecturer or Assistant Professor

The [Faculty of Health Sciences](#) at Western University, invites applications for up to two (2) Limited-Term faculty positions for a two-year duration at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor in the [School of Physical Therapy](#). The workload for the Limited-Term position is 80% teaching and 20% service for applicants with a master's degree or 70% teaching, 10% research, and 20% service for applicants with a doctorate. Rank and salary will be commensurate with the applicant's qualifications and experience. The anticipated start date is July 1, 2024, or as negotiated

In addition to an entry-to-practice physiotherapy degree, applicants will: 1) have completed a master's or doctoral degree in a related field; 2) have excellent organizational and interpersonal skills; and 3) be registered with, or be eligible for registration with, the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario.
