

**Teaching Scholar Track Position in Biomedical Education
Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry
Western University**

The Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, Western University, invites applications for **two probationary Teaching Scholar (TS) positions** in the field of biomedical education. These probationary appointments will be made at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor, depending on the qualifications. Appointments made at the rank of Assistant Professor will lead to consideration of continuing status and promotion to Associate Professor, TS, at the end of the probationary period (maximum 6 years). Appointments made at the rank of Associate Professor will lead to consideration of continuing status at the end of the probationary period (maximum 3 years).

Applicants must have a PhD degree in a relevant biomedical discipline. Additional postgraduate training in the field of Education will be an asset. The candidates should be an emerging or established education scholars with a keen interest in further developing a strong research program in the scholarship of teaching and learning (SoTL). The candidates are also expected to have an outstanding track record of classroom/laboratory/clinical teaching, teaching innovations, and course/curriculum development.

The successful candidate is expected to contribute to the teaching mission of the School in undergraduate, graduate, and/or professional programs. The candidate is also expected to engage in research/scholarly activities that may include (but are not limited to) presentations, publications and funding applications on teaching, pedagogy and/or learning; interdisciplinary course and curriculum development and evaluation; interdisciplinary pedagogical and learning approaches; educational leadership; or other related SoTL research.

Eligibility for Teaching Scholar appointments is open only to those candidates who either currently hold a Limited Term or Limited Duties appointment at Western at the time of recruitment.

- 2) A cover letter addressing how your expertise/experience and proposed scholarship activities fit this position

- 3) An up-to-date curriculum vitae
- 4) A short teaching dossier, including a teaching philosophy statement and a summary of past achievements in classroom teaching, curriculum development, teaching innovation, scholarly activities, etc. (maximum of 3 pages)
- 5) A plan for future scholarship activities (maximum of 2 pages)
- 6) Contact details of at least three references who can provide letters of support
