PROCEDURE FOR POLICY 6.9 – Sick Leave and Long-Term Disability

5. Workplace Safety and Insurance Board or Third Party Payments

PMA Eligible staff members who become entitled to benefits under the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) following a workplace injury or illness will be eligible for WSIB benefits. The amount of the WSIB benefits will be determined in Sections (a) and (b) in [Policy 6.9 - Sick Leave and Long Term Disability](#). The WSIB benefits will be paid to the staff member following completion of the WSIB claim process.

6. Medical Documentation

The University requires medical certification of illness from the attending Health Care Professional (as recognized by OHIP or the Ontario Health Plan) and/or a medical examination by a Health Care Professional chosen by the University. The University will consider a certification necessary if the University is unable to determine the nature and extent of the illness based on the medical examination and notes provided by the Health Care Professional. The University will not accept a certification from a Health Care Professional who is not a member of the Ontario College of Physicians and Surgeons or the Ontario College of Nurses and Midwives.
