COMPOSITION AND RULES OF PROCEDURE

1. The Dean of Education is the chief executive officer of the Faculty and may be assisted by one or

C. The following non-voting members:

- (a) i. Any other person holding a full-time appointment in the Faculty of Education not specifically accorded the right to vote under terms set out in Section 2B(a)
 - ii. part-time or limited duties appointments;
 - iii. a visiting or similar appointment or arrangement;

- 4. The Council may establish such Committees as the Council considers necessary. Although the Council may delegate authority to its Committees, the Committees shall be responsible to Council.
- 5. The quorum for a regular Faculty Council meeting shall consist of a minimum of one-third of the voting members.
- 6. The By-Laws and Regulations for the conduct of the Council's proceedings shall, in general, be those adopted by Senate. The Council and all committees within the Faculty shall follow, in general, the rules and procedures approved by Senate.
- 7. This constitution may be amended by the Senate on recommendation of two-thirds (2/3) of the voting members of the Council in attendance at a regularly constituted meeting prior to which there has been fourteen (14) days notice of the proposed amendment.
